39.80	Set a stone 16x12x10 for 1/4 sec. cor. 10 ins. in the ground marked 1/4 on N side, from which A Laurel, 15 ins. diam., bears S.15*W., 46 lks. dist. Marked 1/4 S B T. A Live Oak, 8 ins. diam., bears N.36*W., 13 lks. dist. Marked 1/4 S B T.
79.60	The cor. to secs. 28, 29, 32, and 33. Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky, 3rd rate. Timber, densely covered with forests of Fir, Pine, and Laurel.
