

Subdivisions of T. 32 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS	
60.20	A creek, 5 lks. wide, course SW. Steep ascent.
71.00	Top of spur, course SW. Gradual descent.
79.56	Intersect N and S line 72 lks. S of the cor. to secs. 3, 4, 9, and 10. Thence I run. S.89°29'W. on a true line between secs. 4 and 9. Same Va.
39.78	Set a Fir post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 20 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on the N side, from which A Fir, 72 ins. diam., bears South, 8 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Fir, 60 ins. diam., bears N.10°W., 17 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
79.56	The cor. to secs. 4, 5, 8, and 9. Land, South slope of mountain, 2nd rate. Timber, dense, chiefly of Fir and Pine. Undergrowth, scattering of Fir and Huckleberry.
	North, on random line between secs. 4 and 5. Va.19°45'E.
3.00	(West Fork) 100 lks. wide, course SW. Ascend East slope.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Descend East slopes.
46.50	West Fork, 100 lks. wide, course SE.
48.00	Steep ascent.
81.42	Intersect N bdy. of tp. 13 lks. East of the cor. to secs. 4, 5, 32, and 33 which is a Fir post firmly set in the ground marked T 31 S R 8 W S 33 on NE, T 32 S S 4 on SE, S 5 on SW, and S 32 on NW faces also four notches on E and 2 notches on W angles of same, and from which A Laurel, 12 ins. diam., bears N.35°E., 35 lks. dist. Marked T 31 S R 8 W S 33 B T. A Sugar Pine, 30 ins. diam. bears S.50°E., 114 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 4 B T. A Laurel, 8 ins. diam., bears S.40°W., 34 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 5 B T.
