	<p>A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.25*W., 71 lks. dist. Marked T 31 S R 8 W S 32 B T. Thence I ran. S.0*o6'E. on a true line between secs. 4 and 5. Va. same.</p>
41.42	<p>A Chinquapin, 6 ins. diam., which I marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W side for the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor., from which A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.10*E., 6 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.10*W., 31 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.</p>
81.42	<p>The cor. to secs. 4, 5, 8, and 9. Land, broken and mountainous. Soil, rocky, 3rd rate. Timber, densely covered with forests of Fir, Pine. Undergrowth, thick, chiefly of Laurel and Fir.</p>
	<p>From the cor. to secs. 31 and 32 on the South bdy. of the tp. which is a post 4 ins. sq., firmly set in the ground and marked S C T 32 S on N, R 8 W S 32 on E, S 31 on W faces also 5 notches on E and 1 notch on W faces, from which a Fir, 22 ins. diam., bears N.47*E., 24 lks. dist. marked S C T 32 S R 8 W S 32 B T. A Fir, 22 ins. diam., bears S.27*W., 30 lks. dist. Marked S C T 33 S R 8 W S 6 B T. A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.26*W., 30 lks. dist. Marked S C T 32 S R 8 W S 31 B T. I ran. North, between secs. 31 and 32. Va.19*45'E.</p>
4.00	<p>Summit of mt., course East and West. Steep descent.</p>
13.25	<p>A creek, 2 lks. wide, course NW. Ascent.</p>
24.00	<p>Top of spur, course NW. Descend.</p>
39.00	<p>A creek, 2 lks. wide, course NW. Ascend.</p>
