CHAINS	
	Descend.
79.93	Intersect at cor. to secs. 28, 29, 32, and 33. Thence I ran. West, on a true line between secs. 29 and 32. Va. same.
39.97	Set a stone 12x12x8 ins., 8 ins. in the ground. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N side for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., from which A Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S.63*E., 20 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.54*W., 22 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
79.93	The cor. to secs. 29, 30, 31, and 32. Land, mountainous and broken. Soil, rocky, 3rd rate. Timber, chiefly Fir and Pine. Undergrowth, densely covered and thick, Laurel, Chinquapin, Fir, Live Oak, Balm, and Huckleberry.
	West, on random line between secs. 30 and 31. Va. 19*45'E.
5.50	Top of ridge, course North. Descend.
15.60	A creek, 3 lks. wide, course NW. Ascend.
34.50	Top of ridge. Trail to Rogue River, course NW.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
43.00	Steep descent.
64.00	A creek, 10 lks. wide, course NW.
80.10	Intersect W bdy. of tp. 30 lks. North of the cor. to secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36, which is A stone, 15x12x8 ins., 10 ins. in the ground marked with one notch on the S and five notches on the N, and from which A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.54*E., 61 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 30 B T. A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.36*E., 93 lks. dist. Marked T 32 S R 8 W S 31 B T.
