CHAINS	
	Steep descent.
25.50	A creek, 5 lks. wide, course North, steep ascent.
36.00	Top of spur, course NW. Steep descent.
40.00	Set temp $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
40.50	A creek, 2 lks. wide, course N.75*W., Steep ascent.
58.00	Top of spur, course NE. Enter broken lands sloping N.
79.60	Intersect N and S line 68 lks. S of the cor. to secs. 8, 9, 16, and 17. Thence I ran. S.89*30'W. on a true line between secs. 8 and 17. Va. same.
39.80	Set a stone 20x10x8 ins., 14 ins. in the ground marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N side for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., from which An Alder, 10 ins. diam., bears N.75*E., 30 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears South, 23 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
79.60	The cor. to secs. 7, 8, 17, and 18. Land, broken and mountainous. Timber, densely covered with forests, chiefly of Pine, Fir and Laurel. Undergrowth, thick, Laurel, Chinquapin, Fir, Balm, and Live Oak.
	West, on random line between secs. 7, and 18. Va.19*45'E.
	Steep ascent.
6.00	Top of high ridge, course NE. Steep descent.
22.20	A creek, 4 lks. wide, course NE. Steep ascent.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Top of ridge, course North. Descend.
57.00	A creek, 5 lks. wide, course NE. Ascend.
79.30	Intersect W bdy of tp. 75 lks. N of the cor. to secs. 7, 12, 13, and 18, which is a stone 18x12x10 ins. firmly set in the ground and marked with 4 notches on the S.
