CHAINS

30, located by reference to the bearing trees as described by the surveyor general; all traces of the cor. post have disappeared. I change this cor. to refer to secs. 19 and 30 only and perpetuate it as follows; at the exact cor. point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 19 and 30, T. 32 S., R. 8 W. only, with brass cap marked
