West, on S. bdy. of sec. 34.

39.49 Intersect the standard $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor.

74.83 Fall 60 lks. N. of the standard cor. of Secs. 33 and 34.

The E. half of this line is West, 39.49 chs., and

the W. half is S.89°01'W., 35.35 chs.

From the standard sec. cor.

West, on S. bdy. of sec. 33.

36.17 Fall 44 lks. S. of the standard $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor.

75.56 Fall 35 lks. N. of the standard cor. of Secs. 32 and 33.

The E. half of this line is N.89°18'W., 36.17 chs.,

and the W. half is S.88°51'W., 39.40 chs.

From the standard sec. cor.

West, on S. bdy. of sec. 32.

39.09 Intersect the standard $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor.

78.29 Fall 11 lks. N. of the standard cor. of Secs. 31 and 32

The E. half of this line is West, 39.09 chs., and

the W. half is S.89°50'W., 39.20 chs.

From the standard sec. cor.

West, on S. bdy. of Sec. 31.

39.91 Fall 10 lks. N. of the standard $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor.

79.82 Fall 8 lks. N. of the standard cor. of Tp. 32 S.,

Rs. 8 and 9 W.

The E. half of this line is S.89°51' W., 39.91 chs.,

and the W. half is N.89°58'W., 39.91 chs.

TRUE LINE.

The standard cor. of Tp. 32 S., Rs. 7 and 8 W., is a Pine post, 4 x 4 ins., 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.
