CHAINS

North, on a Sectional Guide Meridian, bet. secs. 25 and 26.
Descend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

11.30 Top of spur, slopes SW. and N.

23.55 Leave spur, slopes NW.; continue descent.

28.20 Creek, 20 lks. wide, course W.; ascend.

39.40 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SE.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the
ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

ground, for cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26, with brass
cap marked
