Land, mountainous.
 Soil, stony clay loam, 3rd rate.
 Timber, fir and sugar pine.
 Undergrowth, chinquapin, tan oak, buckhorn and rhododendron.

N.89*55'E., on a random line, bet. secs. 13 and 24.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

78.67 Intersect the E. bdy. of the Tp., 2 lks. S. of the cor.
 of secs. 13 and 24.

Thence

S.89*54'W., on a true line, bet. secs. 13 and 24.

Ascend steep slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

38.67 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

$$\frac{1}{4} \frac{S13}{S24} \\ 1917$$

from which

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 85*E., 69 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 24 B T.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.48*30'W., 62 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 13 B T.

39.75 Top of ridge, bears N. and S.; descend.

Trail along ridge, bears N. and S.

56.35 Ravine, course SW.; ascend.

72.00 Top of spur, slopes SW.; descend.

78.67 The cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24.

Land, mountainous.
 Soil, stony clay loam and shale rock, 3rd and 4th rate.
 Timber, fir and sugar pine.
 Undergrowth, chinquapin, tan oak and buckhorn.

North, on a Sectional Guide Meridian, bet. secs. 13 and 14.
 Descend through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.
