

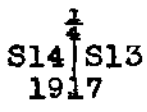
Subdivisions, T. 32 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS

- 6.65 Kelsey Creek, 5 lks. wide, course SW.; ascend.
- 12.10 Trail, bears E. and W.
- 12.87 County trail, Dothan to Gold Beach, bears NE. and SW.
- 13.30 Top of ridge, bears NE. and SW.; descend.

Enter heavy timber, bears NE. and SW.

- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

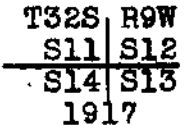

A fir, 30 ins. daim., bears N.36*E., 23 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 13 B T.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.73*W., 68 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 14 B T.

- 64.20 Babes Creek, 4 lks. wide, course W.; ascend.
- 69.30 Ravine, course SW.; continue ascent.
- 77.20 Ravine, course SW.; ascend steep slope.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14, with brass cap marked

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.8*E., 32 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 9 W S 12 B T.

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.23*E., 63 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 9 W S 13 B T.

A laurel, 14 ins. diam., bears S.80*W., 28 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 9 W S 14 B T.

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.85*W., 70 lks. dist., marked T 32 S R 9 W S 11 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, stony clay loam and shale rock, 3rd and 4th rate.
