North, on a true line, bet. secs. 34 and 35.

Ascend through dense undergrowth.

7.00 Top of high spur, slopes SW.; descend steep slope.

Enter heavy timber, bears NE. and SW.

20.00 Ravine, course NW.; along W. slope.

40.04 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

45.75 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course W.; ascend.

48.80 Top of spur, slopes NW.; descend.

50.50 Ravine, course NW.; ascend.

63.00 Top of spur, slopes NW.; descend steep slope.

75.50 Creek, 25 lks. wide, course SW.; ascend steep slope.

75.85 Bluff, 30 ft. high, bears E. and W.

80.04 The cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, stony clayloam and shale rock, 2nd, 3rd and 4th rate.

Timber, fir, sugar pine, laurel and chinquapin.

Undergrowth, tan oak, laurel, buckhorn and chinquapin.

N.0°01'W., bet. secs. 26 and 27.

Ascend steep rocky slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

19.05 Top of rocky spur, slopes NW.; descend.

39.65 Kelsey Creek, 20 lks. wide, course SW.; ascend.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap marked
