CHAINS	
55.25	Top of spur, slopes NW.; descend.
72.10	Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NW.; ascend.
79.72	The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10. Land, mountainous. Soil, shaly clay loam, 3rd rate. Timber, fir, laurel, sugar pine and chinquapin. Undergrowth, tan oak, rhododendron, chinquapin, and vine maple.
40.00	N.0°01'W., on a random line, bet. secs. 3 and 4. Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
69.87	Intersect the N. bdy. of the Tp., 28 lks. E. of the cor. of secs. 3 and 4. Thence S.0°15'E., on a true line, bet. secs. 3 and 4. Descend S. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
7.75	Draw, course W.; along W. slope.
23.00	Top of spur, slopes W.; descend.
29.83	A fir tree, 50 ins. diam., on line, marked with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.
29.87	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

	from which A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.46°E., 41 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 3 B T. A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.68°W., 46 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 4 B T.
32.40	Draw, course W.; ascend.
35.00	Top of spur, slopes W.; descend.
43.00	Ravine, course W.
53.65	Creek, 3 lks. wide, course NW.
66.00	Creek, 2 lks. wide, course W.; ascend.
