- 34.70 Spring, drains SE.
- 39.95 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked

Land, mountainous.

Soil, gravelly loam, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, cedar, sugar pine, laurel and hemlock.

Undergrowth, rhododendron and chinquapin.

Gradual ascent through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
