CHAINS

- 80.22 Intersect the N. and S. line, at the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.  
 Thence  
 N.89°57'W., on a true line, bet. secs. 4 and 9.  
 Descend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.  
 3.25 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N.; ascend.  
 15.75 Ravine, course SE.  
 18.75 Same ravine, course NE.  
 40.11 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked

- A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.77°W., 87 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 9 B T.
- A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.40°W., 108 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 4 B T.
- 44.75 Top of spur, slopes NE.; descend steep slope.  
 54.85 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course NE.; ascend.  
 80.22 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.  
 Land, mountainous.  
 Soil, gravelly clay loam, 2nd and 3rd rate.  
 Timber, fir, sugar pine, chinquapin, yew and cedar.  
 Undergrowth, rhododendron, tan oak, hazel and fir.

- N.0°16'W., on a random line, bet. secs. 4 and 5.  
 40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.  
 70.19 Intersect the N. bdy. of the Tp., 35 lks. W. of the cor. of secs. 4 and 5.  
 Thence  
 S.0°01'W., on a true line, bet secs. 4 and 5.  
 Ascend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.  
 3.95 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NW.  
 14.10 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course W.; begin steep ascent.  
 28.00 Top of ridge, bears NE. and SW.; along S. slope.
