CHAINS

- 64.75 Top of spur, slopes S.
- 66.45 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course S.
- 80.08 The cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20.
Land, mountainous.
Soil, clay loam, 2nd rate.
Timber, fir, sugar pine, chinquapin and laurel.
Undergrowth, tan oak, rhododendron and sweet oak.

- 40.00 N.89*59'W., on a random line, bet. secs. 18 and 19.
Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- 67.74 Intersect the W. bdy. of the Tp., 2 lks. S. of the cor. of
secs. 18 and 19.
Thence
S.89*58'E., on a true line, bet. secs. 18 and 19.
Ascend SW slope, through heavy timber.
- 7.75 Head of ravine, course SW.
- 18.70 Old trail, bears N. and S.
- 18.75 Top of high ridge, bears N. and S.; descend SE. slope.
- 27.74 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 ins diam., 26 ins. in the
ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

- A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.50*W., 8 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 19 B T.

marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 18 B T.
- 29.50 Enter dense undergrowth, bears N. and S.
- 35.70 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course SE.
