- 7.00 Top of spur, slopes NW.; descend.
- 22.35 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course NW.; ascend.
- 27.48 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for P sec. cor., with brass cap marked
- $$\frac{1}{4} \frac{S7}{S18}$$

- A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N.6°E., 24 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 7 B T.
- A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.74°E., 47 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 18 B T.
- 38.00 Top of spur, slopes N.
- 46.80 Ravine, course N.
- 50.70 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NW.
- 55.90 Top of spur, slopes NW.
- 67.48 The cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18.
- Land, mountainous.
- Soil, gravelly clay loam, 2nd rate.
- Timber, fir, sugar pine, chinquapin and hemlock.
- Undergrowth, rhododendron, vine maple, sweet oak and tan oak.
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- N.0°03'W., bet. secs. 7 and 8.
- Along W. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
- 5.15 Ravine, course W.
- 13.00 Top of spur, slopes W.
- 19.70 Ravine, course SW.; ascend SW. slope.
- 29.10 Trail to Cold Spring, bears NW. and SE.
- 31.00 Top of ridge, bears NW. and SE.; descend steep slope.
- 37.00 Foot of steep descent; descend along NE. slope.
