	A Fir, 22 ins. diam., bears S.29*E., 13 lks. dist., marked T 33 S R 4 W S 17 B T.
	A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.80*W., 15 lks. dist., marked T 33 S R 4 W S 18 B T.
	A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.62*W., 60 lks. dist., marked T 33 S R 4 W S 7 B T.
	Land, mountainous, broken, rough, high.
	Soil, gravelly, rocky, 4th rate.
	Heavy timber, Fir, Pine, and Cedar.
