CHAINS	
	N.89*38'E. on a random line between secs. 8 and 17. Va. 18*50'E
40.00	Set temp. 1/4 sec. cor.
80.64	Intersect N. and S. line 45 lks. North of cor. to secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17. Thence I run S.89*55'W., on a true line between secs. 8 and 17. Va. 17*30'E Ascend mountain.
19.64	A Fir, 3 ft. diam., on line, marked with 2 notches on E. and W. sides.
39.65	A Creek (course from swamp) 4 lks. wide, course N.60*E.
40.34	Set a basaltic stone, 18 x 10 x 6 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 on N. face, from which A Fir, 2 ft. diam., bears N.63*E., 33 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S B T. A Fir, 2 ft. diam., bears S.42*W., 16 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S B T.
53.30	Enter small swamp and spring branch, 2 lks. wide, course NE.
56.14	Spring branch, 4 lks. wide, course NE.
58.68	Leave swamp.
77.18	Top of ascent over mountain 800 ft. above sec. cor.
80.64	Descend gradually on N. slope, 50 ft. to The cor. to secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18. Land, mountainous, rough, broken, rolling, high. Soil, gravelly, rocky, 4th rate. Heavy timber, Fir, Pine and Cedar. Dense underbrush, small Fir, Yew, Mountain Laurel, Hazel and Vine Maple, 80.64 chs. September 19 1893.
