CHAINS	
	S.89*55'W. on a random line between secs. 6 and 7. Va. 19*10'E
40.00	Set temp. 1/4 sec. cor.
79.50	Intersect West boundary of township 42 lks. North of cor. to secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12. Thence I run N.89*37'E. on a true line between secs. 6 and 7. Va. 20*E
6.00	Ascend up creek bottom, 50 ft. to Top of ascent. Descend gradually to
13.00	North side of creek 20 lks. wide, course S.80*W., course S.80*E. Ascend mountain on North side of creek.
23.00	A Cedar, 24 ins. diam., on line, marked with 2 notches on E. and W. sides.
39.50	Set a basaltic stone, 12 x 7 x 7 ins., for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 on N. side, from which A Cedar, 20 ins. diam., bears S.30*W., 55 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S B T. A Cedar, 3 ft. diam., bears N.65*E., 11 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S B T.
42.00	Top of ascent 500 ft. above creek. Descend on S. slope.
51.60	A Cedar, 42 ins. diam., on line, marked with 2 notches on E. and W. sides.
55.10	Foot of descent 150 ft. below point at 42. chs. Ravine bears S.70*W. Ascend mountain rapidly, up steep mountain spur on West slope 500 ft.
79.50	The cor. to secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8. Land, mountainous, broken, rough high, sloping to the West. Soil, gravelly, rocky, 4th rate.
