

Subdivisions of T. 33 S., R. 5 W.

CHAINS

A Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.36*30'E., 53 lks. dist.
marked T 33 S R 5 W S 10 B T.

A Matherone, 10 ins. diam., bears S.28*E., 30 lks.
dist, marked T 33 S R 5 W S 15 B T.

A Matherone 7 ins. diam., bears S.7*W., 78 lks. dist.
marked T 33 S R 5 W S 16 B T.

A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.56*W., 11 lks. dist.
marked T 33 S R 5 W S 9 B T.

Land, mountainous, broken, rough.

Heavy timber Fir, Cedar, Pine and Matherone, and live Oak.

Dense underbrush of small Fir, Cedar, Hazel, Live Oak,
and Matherone.

Soil, 3rd rate, gravelly and rocky.

June 13, 1894

South 89*47'E on a random line bet. secs. 10 and 15.

Va 19*E.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.18 Intersect N and S line 29 lks. S. of cor. to secs. 10
and 11, 14 and 15.

Thence I run W on a true line between secs 10 and 15.

Va 21*E.

Descend 100 ft. on W slope, to creek and ft. of descent at

1.35 Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N to NW.

4.67 A Fir, 40 ins. diam. line tree, marked with two notches
on E and W sides.

5.95 Top of narrow divide +100 ft. bears NW and Se. Descend
abruptly.

8.04 Foot of descent -100 and creek, 10 lks. wide, course NW.
Ascend on N Slope.

19.72 A Fir, 3 ft. diam. line tree marked with 2 notches on
E and W sides.

21.30 Top of ascent +100 and descend on N slope.

21.63 Trail bears N and S.
