CHAINS		
12.65	Ravine, 10 ft. deep bears W.	
16.52	A Fir, 36 ins. diam. line tree, marked with two notches on N and S sides.	
19.90	Top of ridge +100 ft. bears NW. Descend on NE slope.	
27.30	Foot of steep descent and spring branch 2 lks. wide, course NW. Ascend on NW slope.	-150
30.30	Top of ascent and mt. spur, bears NW and descend on steep N slope.	+150
33.00	A Fir, 48 ins. diam. line tree, marked with 2 notches on N and S sides.	
33.45	Miners ditch bears W.	
33.80	Foot of steep descent.	-150
34.80	Wolf Creek, 20 lks. wide, bears S.80*W.	
36.80	Wagon Road, bears E and S W, leading from mines to Wolf Creek Station.	
37.30	Leave timber, a rail fence and enter enclosure belonging to A. D. Lethman. Enclosure lying mostly W of the line, consisting of house, barn and 10 acres of cleared ground into grass and grain. Ascend gradually over bottom S slope.	
38.70	Ditch bears W.	
39.08	Fence bears E and W.	
40.00	Set basaltic stone 12 x 10 x 8 ins. 8 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W side from which A Fir, 42 ins. diam., bears N.4*10*W., 304 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.31*45*E., 237 lks. dist, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.	
40.00	The S gable end of house bears S.83*36*W about 5.00 chs. dist.	
43.00	Enter dense timber.	
46.50	Brush fence and leave enclosure.	
47.10	Ditch bears W.
