Ascend on steep SW slope 100 ft. to

66.65 Top of ascent and mt. spur bears S and descend on steep SE slope.

68.00 Dead Y. Pine, 40 ins. diam. line tree marked with 2 notches on E and W sides.

68.21 Ravine 40 ft. deep bears S.20°E.

74.66 The cor. to secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8.

Land, mountainous, high, broken, rough.

Heavy timber of Oak, Fir, Matherone, Pine and Cedar.

Dense underbrush of Oak, Hazel, Fir and Matherone.

Soil 3rd rate, gravelly.

2.00 Small Ravine bears SE, and ascend on E side on steep ascent.

11.50 Small Ravine 5 ft. deep bears S.10°W.

11.90 B. Oak, 18 ins. diam. line tree marked with 2 notches on N and S sides.

28.05 Summit of sharp divide between Wolf and Cow Creeks, bears NE and SW +1000 ft. above sec. cor. S.

Descend on steep NW slope.

36.07 A Fir, 30 ins. diam., line tree, marked with 2 notches on N and S sides.

40.00 Set a basaltic stone 18 x 8 x 6 ins. 12 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W side from which
A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.17°E., 90 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.19°W., 55 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
