Land mountainous rocky 3rd rate.

Timber scattering Oak, Laurel, Fir and Pine.

May 15th, 1882.

East on Random Line between Secs. 8 and 17

Va. 18\*E.

Along N slope of mountain.

40.00 Set temporary  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor.

57.50 Top of Ridge course E

70.00 Descend Steep rocky bluff.

80.09 Intersect Sec. Line 34 lks N of Cor. to Secs 8, 9, 16  
and 17

Thence

N 89\*45' W on True Line between Secs. 8 and 17

40.05 Set A Fir post 4 feet long 4 ins. sq. 18 ins. in the

9.00 Creek 2 lks wide course N.

24.50 Creek 3 lks. wide course NE steep ascent
