80.33 Intersect N. and S. line 67 lks. South of corner to secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14, thence

S.89°32'W. on true line between secs. 11 and 14.

40.16 Set a Fir post, 40 ins. long, 20 ins. in the ground, marked 1/4 S on N. side, for the 1/4 sec. corner, from which

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.8°W., 66 lks. dist.,
Marked 1/4 S B T and

A Pine, 14 ins. diam., bears N.10°W., 97 lks. dist.,
Marked 1/4 S B T.

80.33 To corner to secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15.

Timber, chiefly, Fir, Pine, Oak and Laurel.

North between secs. 10 and 11.

Va. 17°30'E.

12.50 Top of high mountain, Course E. and W, Descend.

40.00 Set a Chinquapin post, 40 ins. long, 20 ins. in the ground, 4 ins. square, marked 1/4 S on W. side, for the 1/4 sec. corner, from which
