	<p>Land, mountainous, very rough.</p> <p>Soil, rocky, fourth rate.</p> <p>Timber, Fir, Cedar, Pine, Laurel, Live and Burr Oak,</p> <p>Undergrowth, small Firs and Laurel, Burr Oak and Manzanita.</p> <p>Mountainous or heavily timbered land or covered with a dense undergrowth. 79.73 chs.</p>
	<p>N.0°1'W. between secs. 8 and 9.</p> <p>Ascend SE. slope of mountain, very steep and covered by a dense undergrowth of Wax Myrtles, Manzanita and Burr Oaks, scattering large Firs.</p>
10.00	<p>Top of ridge, bears SW. and NE. 150 feet above sec. corner; continue a moderate ascent of SW slope.</p>
26.00	<p>A mountain trail, bears E. and W.</p>
32.75	<p>Mountain ridge, dividing the waters of Cow Creek and Rogue River, bears E. and W., 150 feet above top of ridge, begin steep and rocky descent.</p>
34.00	<p>Enter heavy growth of large Fir timber, bears E. and W.</p>
37.30	<p>A Fir, 14 ins. diam., for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner, I marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 8 on W. side, and 9 on E. side, from which</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears East, 3 lks. dist.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 9 B T.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.48°W., 22 lks. dist.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 8 B T.</p> <p>This corner stands 150 feet below dividing ridge</p> <p>Continue steep descent.</p>
61.70	<p>A stream, 2 lks. wide, Course W., 300 feet below $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner. Continue to descend N. slope of mountain.</p>
72.00	<p>Enter dense undergrowth of Laurel, Chinquapin, Live Oak, and Wax Myrtle.</p>
80.00	<p>Set a Laurel post, 3 feet long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground, for corner of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9, marked</p>
