80.48	<p>The corner of secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18. Land, mountainous. Soil, gravelly, third rate. Timber, Fir, Sugar Pine, Cedar, Laurel. Undergrowth, small Firs, Burr and Live Oak. Mountainous or heavily timbered land or covered with dense undergrowth. 80.48 chs.</p>
40.00	<p>S.89*53'W. on a random line between secs. 7 and 18. Set temporary $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. corner.</p>
80.22	<p>Intersect W. boundary of Township 21 lks. North of corner of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18.</p>
	<p>August 12, 1901.</p>
0.77	<p>North 89*44'E. on a true line between 7 and 18. Descend mountainslope covered with heavy timber and dense undergrowth. A stream, 8 lks. wide, Course S., 40 feet below corner begin a very steep ascent over bluffs on W. slope of mountain.</p>
23.20	<p>Top of mountainridge, bears N. and S., 500 feet above stream, begin a steep, rocky descent.</p>
40.22	<p>Set a granite stone, 18 x 12 x 8 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. corner, marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on N. face, from which</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A Laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears N.10*W., 21 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S 7 B T.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A Sugar Pine, 5 ins. diam., bears S.29*E., 27 lks. dist., Marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S 18 B T.</p> <p>Continue descent of E. slope. This $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. stands 250 feet below top of mountain ridge.</p>
50.65	<p>A stream, 2 lks. wide, Course S., 200 feet below $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. corner, begin steep ascent.</p>
