

Subdivisions of T. 33 S., R. 7 W.

CHAINS	
	S.89*56'E. on a true line between secs. 6 and 7.
	Descend N. slope of mountain, covered heavily with timber.
27.90	A stream, 3 lks. wide, Course S., 300 feet below corner begin ascent of a S. slope of a spur.
37.00	Top of spur, bears N. and S., 100 feet above stream begin descent.
40.65	Set a granite stone, 12 x 12 x 7 ins., 8 ins. in the ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, from which A Fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.2*W., 44 lks. dist., Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 6 B T. A Sugar Pine, 8 ins. diam., bears S.50*W., 65 lks. dist., Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 7 B T.
	Continue descent of steep slope.
49.15	A stream, 2 lks. wide, Course S., 80 feet below $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner, begin ascent of W. slope, very steep, rocky and covered with a dense undergrowth of small Live and Burr Oak and Manzanita.
55.50	Top of spur, bears N. and S., 200 feet above stream, leave large timber, begin descent of S. slope, with same undergrowth.
72.10	A dry gulch, Course S., 80 feet below top of spur, begin ascent of SW. slope.
80.65	The corner of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8, 100 feet above gulch. Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky and gravelly, third and fourth rate. Timber, Fir, Sugar and Yellow Pine, Cedar, Laurel. Undergrowth, small live and Burr Oak, Manzanita. Mountainous or heavily timbered land or covered with a dense undergrowth. 80.65 chs.

	Ascent SW. slope of mountain, covered by a dense under- growth.
