	Descend from ridge through heavy timber.

40.00	Set a slate stone, 15x9x8 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face; from which

	A Pine, 18 ins. diam., bears S.17*E., 134 lks. dist., mkd. T 33 S R 8 W S 18 B T.
	A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.53 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 138 lks. dist., mkd. T 33 S R 9 W S 13 B T.
	A Fir, 26 ins. diam., bears N.44*W., 42 lks. dist., mkd. T 33 S R 9 W S 12 B T.
