

Subdivisions of T. 33 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

Timber, Fir, Pine and Madrona.

Undergrowth, Chinquapin, Buckhorn and Manzanita.

North, on Sectional Guide Meridian between sec. 1 and 2.

Desc. 10 ft. over N. slope, through heavy green timber and dense undergrowth.

0.50 Ravine, course NW., asc. 40 ft. over SW. slope.

15.30 Spur, slopes NW., desc. 440 ft. over NE. slope.

40.00 Set a granite stone, 16 x 12 x 8 ins., 11 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face; from which

A Pine, 40 ins. diam., bears N.58*E., 30 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S.1 B T.

A Pine, 30 ins. diam., bears S.60*W., 12 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 2 B T.

Desc. 335 ft. over NE. slope.

70.20 Branch, 3 lks. wide, course NW., asc. 210 ft. over SW. slope.

84.21 Intersect 7th Standard Parallel South, 0.82 chs., N.89*53'W. from the standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36, heretofore described.

At point of intersection,

Set a granite stone, 15 x 10 x 8 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2, mkd. 6C on S., with 1 groove on E. and 5 grooves on W. face, from which

A Madrona, 10 ins. diam., bears S.42*E., 53 lks. dist., mkd. T 33 S R 8 W S 1 CC B T.

A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.20*W., 43 lks. dist., mkd. T 33 S R 8 W S 2 C C B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loose, coarse, rocky loam, 3rd rate.

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
