79.25 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NE.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 35 and 36 only, with brass cap marked

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.30\*W., 49 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 1 E S 35 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, coarse gravelly loam; 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, pine and cedar.

Undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron and hazel.

West, on S. bdy. of sec. 35.

Asc. 230 ft. over E. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

5.20 Spur, slopes N.60\*E.; thence along N. slope.

11.75 Asc. 160 ft. over E. slope.
