- 84.00 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course NE.; asc. 20 ft. over SE. slope.
- 89.04 The cor. of Tps. 24 and 25 S., R. 1 E., only, hereinbefore described.
- Land, mountainous.
- Soil, coarse rocky loam; 2nd and 3rd rate.
- Timber, fir, hemlock, pine and cedar.
- Undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron, arrow-wood, manzanita and hazel.
