Undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron, huckleberry,  
hazel and gooseberry.

Desc. gradually along bottom land, through heavy timber  
and dense undergrowth.

7.50 Deep Creek, 15 lks. wide, course NW.

9.00 Same creek, course NE.

10.50 Same creek, course N.15°W.; thence over flat.

14.00 Ascend along W. slope.

15.00 Dry ravine, course W.

16.00 Spur, slopes S.75°W.; continue along broken W. slope.

28.00 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course W.

37.25 Spur, slopes W.; desc. N. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in  
the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked

51.00 Steamboat Falls, 25 ft. high, bears East, 8 chs. dist.

53.40 Steamboat Creek, 110 lks. wide, course N.80°W., asc.  
510 ft. over S. slope.

55.18 Steamboat Trail and Forest Service telephone line,  
bears N.80°W., and S.80°E.

72.85 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 215 ft. over N. slope.

76.35 Bluff, 40 ft. high, faces N.

77.90 Dry ravine, course E.
