

Subdivision of T. 25 S., R. 1 E.

CHAINS

- 49.25 Continue asc. along steep, rocky E. slope.
- 61.00 A bluff, 40 ft. high, bears W., 20 lks. dist.
- 66.00 Johnson way trail, bears NW. and SE.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24, with brass cap marked

- A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.69*E., 31 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 1 E S 13 B T.
- A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S.68*E., 12 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 1 E S 24 B T.
- A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.80*W., 51 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 1 E S 23 B T.
- A cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears N.29*W., 27 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 1 E S 14 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, coarse rocky loam; 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar and pine.

Undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron, arrow-wood, hazel and manzanita.

S.89*52'E., on a random line, bet. secs. 13 and 24.

- 40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

- 80.12 Intersect E. bdy. of the Tp., at the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, hereinbefore described.

Thence

N.89*52'W., on a true line, bet. secs. 13 and 24.

Along S. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
