- 52.30 Leave dry ravine, course NW.; continue desc. over NW.; slope.
- 64.80 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SW.; 490 ft. below  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. Asc. 105 ft. along S. slope.
- 75.00 Spur, slopes SW.; desc. 140 ft. over NW. slope.
- 80.00 The cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14.  
Land, mountainous.  
Soil, rocky; 3rd and 4th rate.  
Timber, fir and cedar.  
Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel and manzanita.

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- N.0\*01'W., bet. secs. 11 and 12.  
Desc. NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
- 3.90 Dry ravine, course SW.; asc. SE. slope.
- 17.20 Spur, slopes SW., 405 ft. above sec. cor.  
Desc. 150 ft. over NW. slope.
- 26.95 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SW.; ascend 380 ft. to  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. along W. slope.
- 34.00 Dry ravine, course SW.
- 40.00 Spur, slopes W.  
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.35 $\frac{1}{4}$ \*W., 12 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 11 B T.

Desc. 70 ft. over W. slope.
- 50.20 Dry ravine, course SW.; asc. 195 ft. over S. slope.
- 55.50 Spur, slopes SW.; thence along W. slope.
- 65.30 Johnson trail, bears NW. and SE.
