East, on a random line, between secs. 27 and 34.

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

79.98 Intersect N. and S. line at the cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35.

Thence

West, on a true line, bet. secs. 27 and 34.

Desc. 30 ft. along N. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

2.30 Dry ravine, course NE.; asc. 265 ft. over E. slope.

11.50 Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 565 ft. over SW. slope.

30.00 Dry ravine, course SW.; continue desc. over SW. slope.

36.50 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NW.

37.00 Spur, slopes N.

37.80 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N.; asc. 80 ft. over steep NE. slope.

39.99 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked

51.00 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 710 ft. over SW. slope.

73.35 Black Creek, 5 lks. wide, course N., in rocky gorge 40 ft. deep.

Asc. 235 ft. over E. slope.

79.98 The cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, coarse rocky loam; 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar and pine.

Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel and rhododendron.
