- 72.60 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 125 ft. over SE. slope.
- 77.50 Spur, slopes SE.; desc. 20 ft. over SW. slope.
- 79.68 The cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky loam; 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar and pine.

Undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron and hazel.

N.0*02*W., bet. secs. 21 and 22.

Asc. 30 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 2.00 Spur, slopes SE.; desc. 20 ft. over NE. slope.
- 5.40 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 840 ft. over SW. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked
