- 72.15 Brook, 2 lks. wide, course SE.
- 80.00 A fir, 12 ins. diam., for cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16,
I mark
- T 25 S S 10 on NE.,
R 1 E S 15 on SE.,
S 16 on SW., and
S 9 on NW. side; from which
- A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.28 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E., 81 lks.
dist., marked T 25 S R 1 E S 10 B T.
- A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears S.14*E., 17 lks.
dist., marked T 25 S R 1 E S 15 B T.
- A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.32*W., 65 lks.
dist., marked T 25 S R 1 E S 16 B T.
- A fir, 22 ins. diam., bears N.52 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 27 lks.
dist., marked T 25 S R 1 E S 9 B T.
- Land, mountainous.
- Soil, rocky loam; 2nd and 3rd rate.
- Timber, fir, hemlock and cedar.
- Undergrowth, vine maple, chinquapin, rhododendron and
hazel.
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- 40.00 N.89*50'E., on a random line, bet. secs. 10 and 15.
Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- 79.90 Intersect N. and S. line, 16 lks. N. of the cor. of
secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15.
- Thence
- S.89*57'W., on a true line, bet. secs. 10 and 15.
Asc. 500 ft. to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. over E. slope, through heavy
timber and dense undergrowth.
- 2.50 Continue asc. over SE. slope.
