

Subdivision of T. 25 S., R. 1 E.

CHAINS

Timber, fir, hemlock, pine and cedar.

Undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron, manzanita, laurel and hazel.

East, on a random line, bet. secs. 28 and 33.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.30 Intersect N. and S. line, 21 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34.

Thence

N.89*51'W., on a true line, bet. secs. 28 and 33.

Ascend 175 ft. over E. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

5.50 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 600 ft. over steep NW. slope.

10.50 Top of bluff, 70 ft. high, faces NW.

27.80 Top of bluff, 40 ft. high, faces NW.

28.50 Steamboat Creek, 165 lks. wide, in rocky channel, course S.60*W.; asc. 165 ft. over SE. slope to

40.15 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

from which

A madrona, 6 ins. diam., bears N.9*E., 28 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 28 B T.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.50*W., 54 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 33 B T.

Asc. 450 ft. to sec. cor.

43.30 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course SE.

56.80 Steamboat Trail and Forest Service telephone line, bears NE. and SW.
