68.90 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course SE.

80.30 The cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, coarse rocky loam; 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, pine and madrona.

Undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron, hazel, manzanita and laurel.

N.0\*03'W., bet. secs. 28 and 29.

Asc. 400 ft. to  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., over gradual SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

21.90 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course SE.; continue asc. over SW. slope.

33.75 Dry ravine, course W.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked
