40.20 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

A hemlock, 8 ins. diam., bears S.24 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E., 17 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 21 B T.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.19 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 26 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 16 B T.

Continue asc. over NE. slope, 175 ft. to

50.80 Spur, slopes SE.; desc. 350 ft. over SW. slope.

76.60 Siwash Creek, 6 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 40 ft. over E. slope.

77.90 Desc. SE. slope.

80.40 The cor. of secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, coarse rocky loam; 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar and pine.

Undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron and hazel.

N.0*03'W., bet. secs. 16 and 17.

Asc. SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

5.00 Spur, slopes SE.; thence along E. slope.

6.20 Siwash Creek, 3 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. SW. slope.

25.50 Top of spur ridge, bears NW. and SE., slopes SE. 410 ft. above sec. cor.; desc. 160 ft. to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., over NE. slope.

33.00 Dry ravine, course E.; thence along E. slope.

37.00 Dry ravine, course E.
