40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.28 Intersect N. and S. line, 5 lks. N. of the cor. of secs.
9, 10, 15 and 16.

Thence

N.89*45'W., on a true line, bet. secs. 9 and 16.

Asc. SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense under-
growth.

14.10 Brook, 2 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. NE. slope.

40.14 Spur, slopes SE.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in
the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked
