

## Subdivision of T. 25 S., R. 1 E.

CHAINS

65.00 Spur, slopes SE.; desc. NE. slope.

85.02 Intersect S. bdy. of sec. 33, T. 24 S., R. 1 E., 1.98 chs. N.88°59'E. of the cor. of secs. 32 and 33 only, hereinbefore described.

At the point of intersection set the closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5, hereinbefore described.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky; 3rd and 4th rate.

Timber, fir, pine and cedar.

Undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron, hazel, manzanita and laurel.

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From the cor. of secs. 31 and 32 only, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., hereinbefore described,

N.0°04'W., bet. secs. 31 and 32.

Desc. 800 ft. to Steamboat Creek over NW. slope.

4.50 Continue desc. over N. slope.

9.00 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NW.; thence along W. slope.

10.95 Spur, slopes NW.; continue desc. over N. slope.

15.50 Continue desc. over NW. slope.

25.15 Left bank of Steamboat Creek, course S.20°W.

27.40 Right bank of Steamboat Creek; thence over bare rocky high water channel of creek.

33.45 Leave channel, bears NE. and SW.; asc. steep SE. slope.

34.65 Steamboat trail and Forest Service telephone line, bears NE. and SW.

Thence with traverse around foot of impassible bluff facing SE.

N.46½°E., 3.41 chs.

N.41½°W., 1.91 "

West, 1.20 "

38.43 Regain line above bluff.

Thence

N.0°03'W., continuing measurement.
