CHAINS

75.73 Intersect the Willamette Meridian, 2.48 chs. S.0°22'W. of the cor. of secs. 24 and 25 only, hereinbefore described

At the point of intersection set the closing cor. of secs. 19 and 30, hereinbefore described.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky loam; 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar and pine.

Undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron, hazel, laurel and manzanita.

From the cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30, N.0°04'W., bet. secs. 19 and 20.

Desc. NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

1.75 Dry ravine, course SE.; thence along broken E. slope.

28.00 Dry ravine, course E.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.77°E., 34 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 20 B T.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.16 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 85 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 19 B T.

53.50 Top of spur ridge, bears NE. and SW.; slopes SW. Thence along W. slope.

59.00 Spur, slopes W., 100 ft. above  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.; desc. 170 ft. over NW. slope, to creek.

66.00 Dry ravine, course W.
