 74.50 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course W.; asc. 140 ft. over SW. slope.
 80.00 A fir, 10 ins. diam., for cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20, I mark

T 25 S S 17 on NE.,

R 1 E S 20 on SE.,

S 19 on SW., and

S 18 on NW. side; from which

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.35*E., 25 lks.

dist., marked T 25 S R 1 E S 17 B T.

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.58*E., 31 lks.

dist., marked T 25 S R 1 E S 20 B T.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.53*W., 89 lks.

dist., marked T 25 S R 1 E S 19 B T.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.65*W., 8 lks.

dist., marked T 25 S R 1 E S 18 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky loam; 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar and pine.

Undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron, hazel, manzanita and laurel.

- 80.04 Intersect N. and S. line, 12 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21.
