CHAINS

70.75 Top of spur ridge, bears NE. and SW.; desc. 90 ft. over SW. slope.

79.96 The cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18.  
Land, mountainous.  
Soil, rocky loam; 2nd and 3rd rate.  
Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar and pine.  
Undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron, willow and hazel.

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West, on a true line, bet. secs. 7 and 18.  
Desc. 515 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

15.20 Dry ravine, course S.; asc. 100 ft. over gradual E. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked

41.50 Spur, slopes SW.; desc. 1200 ft. over steep W. slope.

74.80 Top of bluff, 100 ft. high, faces W.

77.51 Intersect the Willamette Meridian, 2 lks. S.0°58'E. of the witness cor. to the cor. of secs. 12 and 13 only, on the S. side of bluffs, hereinbefore described.

At the point of intersection set the closing cor. of secs. 7 and 18, hereinbefore described.
