A pine, 8 ins. in diam., bears N.59\*W., 43 lks.  
dist., mkd. T 25 S R 1 E S 31 B T

Land, mountainous.

Soil, coarse rocky loam, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine, cedar and hemlock.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, rhododendron and hazel.

West, on a true line on the S. bdy. of sec. 31

Desc. 400 ft. over N W. slope, through heavy timber and  
dense undergrowth.

9.85 Dry ravine course NW.; asc. 25 ft. along N. slope.

11.80 Desc. 400 ft. over N W. slope.

21.92 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 32 only, later de-  
termined.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in  
the ground, for the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 32 only, with
