

Resurvey of the S. bdy. of sec. 36, T 25 S., R. 1 W.

CHAINS

- 19.30 Draw, course S., asc. 198 ft. over SE. slope.
- 28.50 Spur, slopes S., desc. 300 ft. over SW. slope.
- 38.20 Draw, course S., asc. 60 ft. over low bluffs facing SE.
- 39.51 Intersect the cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T 25 S., R. 1 W. only, which is a point of a basalt outcrop, 16x8x6 ins. above ground, mkd. with a cross (X) for exact point of cor. and five grooves on W. and one groove on E. side of cross.

From which,

A cross (X) on the face of rock outcrop, 3 ft. high, bears N.45*E., 19 lks. dist., rock mkd.

A Oregon maple, 5 ins. in diam., bears N.62*W., 63 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 1 W S 35 B T.

Land; mountainous.

Soil; rocky loam, 3rd rate.

Timber; fir, cedar, hemlock, and madrona.

Undergrowth; hazel, snowbrush, vinemaple, Oregon maple, and rhododendron

Survey of the E. Bdy. of T. 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ S., R. 1 E.

From the cor. of Tps. 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ and 26 S., Rs. 1 and 2 E., as described in the notes of T. 26 S., R. 1 E.

Thence,

North, bet. secs. 31 and 36

Descend 450 ft. over broken N.E. slope, through timber and brush.

- 34.23 Intersect the N. bdy. of the Tp., 18.83 chs. E. of the cor. of secs. 35 and 36 only, hereinbefore described.

At point of intersection;

A pine, 48 ins. in diam., for the closing Tp. cor. of T. 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ S., Rs. 1 and 2 E., I mark.
