From the cor. of Tps. 24 and 25 S., Rs. 2 E., as described in the field notes of T. 24 S., R. 2 E. South, on a random line for distance only, along the East bdy. of T. 25 S., R. 2 E., setting temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cors. and sec. cors. at intervals of 40.00 chains, and at

499.78 Intersect line projected east from the cor. of Tps. 25 S., Rs. 1 and 2 E., only.

At point of intersection set the cor of Tps. 25 S., Rs. 2 and 3 E. only, hereinbefore described
