A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S.75*W., 8 lks.
dist., marked T 25 S R 2 E S 36 B T

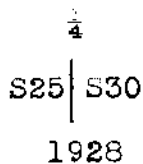
A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.29*W., 42 lks.
dist., marked T 25 S R 2 E S 25 B T

Land; mountainous
Soil; rocky, 4th rate.
Timber; fir, cedar, pine, hemlock, and madrona.
Undergrowth; vinemaple, rhododendron, hazel, mountain laurel, and arrow wood.

North, bet. secs. 25 and 30.

Along broken E. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 9.00 Spur, slopes NE., desc. 160 ft. over NE. slope.
- 14.00 Enter old burn, bears NW. and SE., thence through scattering timber and very dense undergrowth.
- 16.00 Draw, course NE., asc. 93. ft. over SE. slope.
- 20.80 Spur, slopes E., desc. 116 ft. over NE. slope.
- 25.00 Draw, course S.70*E., asc. 147 ft. over S. slope.
- 30.00 Spur, slopes S.70*E., desc. 86 ft. over N. slope.
- 35.00 Draw, course S.60*E., 187 ft. over S. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor of secs. 25 and 30, with brass cap marked
