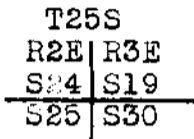


East Boundary of T. 25 S., R. 2 E .

S slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25, and 30 with brass cap marked

from which,

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.47*E., 25 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 3 E S 19 B T

A fir, 4 ins. diam., bears S.21*E., 15 lks. dist., marked B T only.

A fir, 6 ins. diam. bears S.55*W., 27 lks. dist., marked T25 S R 2 E S 25 B T

A fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N.88*W., 12 lks. dist., marked T 25 S E 2 E s 24 B T.

Land; mountainous.

Soil; rocky, 4th rate.

Timber; fir, pine, cedar, and madrona.

Undergrowth; mountain laurel, manzanita, rhododendron, hazel, and vinemaple.

North, bet. secs. 19 and 24.

Asc. 120 ft. over SE. slope, through old burn, scattering timber and dense undergrowth.

3.40 Spur, slopes E., desc. 40 ft. over NE. slope.

9.40 Draw, course SE., asc. 580 ft. over broken SE. slope.

23.00 Leave old burn, bears E. and W., thence through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in diam., 20 ins. in the ground, for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 19 and 24, with brass cap marked
